- **For 6 months after purchase, FOBL members have the sole right to reserve, and borrow, all new FOBL books.** Two new FOBL books may be borrowed, and one more reserved, at any one time.
- **FOBL will pay the library reservation fee, for one FOBL book reservation at a time.** Once you borrow the reserved book you may reserve another. Reserve the books you want to read.
- **FOBL members may also borrow two extra non-FOBL library books**
- **We welcome all suggestions of new book titles you would like us to consider purchasing. Suggestions can be WhatsApped or emailed to us.** As a current FOBL member, you may reserve them too.
- **The cost of administration of FOBL is more than covered by the sale of old books donated by members. All money received from donations go to buy new books for the library.**
